The unique Halo® SleepSack® is a wearable blanket that replaces loose blankets in the crib that can cover a baby's face and interfere with breathing. Providing SleepSacks® encourages parents and caregivers to follow the American Academy of Pediatrics Safe Sleep Task Force recommendation of a blanket free sleep environment for infants under one year of age.

In addition to the sleeping safer, the SleepSack® wearable blanket helps babies sleep better too. It's a warm, cuddly blanket they can't kick off ensuring baby sleeps soundly throughout the night in a safe environment. And its unique adjustable swaddle allows for swaddling arms in or arms out for an easy and gentle transition when it's time to stop swaddling.

Providing safe sleep tools such as the SleepSack® equips parents and caregivers to provide the safest sleep environment for their infant.



How to use the Halo® SleepSack® Swaddle wearable blanket?

Slip the SleepSack® Swaddle wearable blanket over the baby's regular sleepwear as a replacement to loose blankets in the crib. The baby's clothing underneath the wearable blanket (short or long sleeve, fleece or cotton pajamas, etc.) will depend on the room/house temperature. It is important that babies aren't dressed too warm and that they aren't put to sleep wearing a hat as this can result in overheating. If swaddling, secure the velcro swaddle wrap around your baby. You may choose to use the swaddle feature with arms in or arms out.
