### Aly's Story

As told by her parents Jeremy & Elise McCulley



As a young family just starting out, my husband, Jeremy, and I, Elise, had two little boys, Wesley and Gage, when we

found out on February 17, 2005, that I was pregnant. We were a little nervous at first, but as time passed and we found out we were having a girl, we became excited. My pregnancy was a little rough but for the most part healthy. On Sunday, September 4, 2005, at 1:01 p.m., Alyzae Marie McCulley came into the world weighing in at 6 lbs. 7.7 oz. and 19 inches long. Our first daughter was born. With big dark blue eyes and blondish-brown hair, she was beautiful, strong and healthy. We couldn't have asked for more; everything was great. The day she came home from the hospital, I laid her on her tummy, and she rolled herself over because she didn't like it. She did this any time we put her on her tummy. She was strong and had us convinced she was the boss by the time she was two weeks old.

Friday, October 7, 2005, was a typical day for our family. We went to sleep that night as we normally did. I had shared my bed with my previous child, so it wasn't new for me to do the same with Aly. On Saturday, October 8, 2005, I fed her at 7 a.m., then went back to sleep. Around 10:25 a.m. our phone rang and we realized Jeremy was late for work. We both jumped out of bed, and I checked the phone to see who had called. Jeremy came back in the room and turned the light on. As he did this, I looked at Alyzae and saw blood coming out of her nose and mouth. (I later learned this happens when the body passes.) I immediately dialed 911 and started CPR. I stayed on the phone with dispatch and repeated the steps over and over. I heard sirens coming closer, and then

they passed. I ran outside with Aly in my arms and laid her in my lap on the porch and continued CPR. Jeremy flagged down the ambulance, and the paramedics took over. I wasn't sure what to think, I just kept hoping she was going to be okay. I asked EMS if I could ride with Alyzae, and they agreed. Then a police officer stopped me and asked me to please have a seat and if I had an I.D. This was so confusing to me. They had no answers for me but instead had numerous questions.

Before I knew it, my father showed up, followed shortly behind by my mother, brother and sister-in-law. My dad told the police he was taking Jeremy and me to the hospital. The police followed us to the hospital but had no information for us. When we arrived at the hospital the officers escorted us to a room. Shortly thereafter, they took us down the hall to a door guarded by an officer. A doctor came around the corner and said, "I'm sorry, but your daughter was dead upon arrival." I will never forget those words. I hit the ground crying and asking, "Why, what happened?" The only answer I received was, "I don't know."

I asked where she was and if I could see her. At that point, the guarded door opened, and there she lay, wrapped in a blanket. Nobody could tell me what had happened to my baby. A little while later, they pulled us out of the room because we had to make an important decision. They wanted to know if we wanted to donate her organs. It took me a while to comprehend, but we agreed that it was the right thing to do. Later the coroner arrived to inform us our daughter had passed away from what they believed was SIDS (Sudden Infant Death Syndrome), and their investigation was over. This was when they were able to answer my question as to why she was bleeding. They explained a broken membrane from her body passing caused the bleeding. I was so lost. I didn't know what to think or do.

I called the coroner's office every day. I had to know what had happened and why. In my world, babies didn't die without a reason. I needed to know why I was burying my daughter at 5 weeks and 4 days old. Most of

our family still had not met Aly. It was supposed to be the other way around. I had not experienced a loss this close before.

After a couple days of me calling the coroner's office, they contacted the SIDS Network of Kansas, which in turn contacted me. I will never forget my first conversation with the Network. The support was so warm and soothing, and their patience welcomed my million-and-one questions. I will never forget their patience with my non-understanding and impatience. They answered the phone every time I called, day or night, and I needed that. Somebody was there, and that was important. The SIDS Network immediately mailed grief packets to us and our extended family. The packet included something for everybody, including our boys. We had no concept of how much this affected everybody. The SIDS Network of Kansas has provided so much to our family.

Almost two weeks after Alyzae passed, we attended our first support group. That night we met another family that had lost their son the same morning. It was the support meetings that made us feel normal in our grieving process and also made us realize that SIDS is a problem. We attended the SIDS Network monthly support meetings and annual candle lighting memorial. We have appreciated the SIDS Network of Kansas so much for all they have done. They have provided so much support to our family and awareness to our communities.

Community awareness has become important to our family. We have been honored, for over a year now, to volunteer as facilitators for the Topeka support group meetings. We and a few other Topeka families organized the First Annual SIDS Walk of Topeka (con't on page 2)

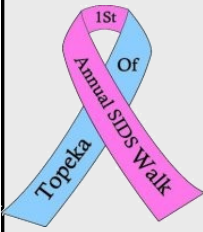

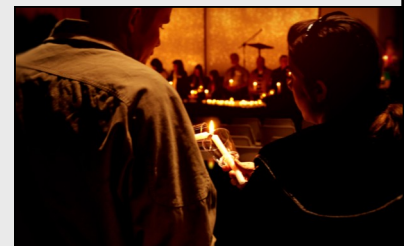

**Governor's Conference on Public Health, Wichita, KS, April 24, 2012.** This year the SIDS Network will present the breakout session, "Splish Splash...Join Us for a Baby Shower Bash." Network staff will demonstrate how to host a Community Baby Shower for Safe Sleep; an interactive event that invites new and expectant mothers, their support people and community service providers to get together for an educational "baby shower." At the shower, participants learn about infant safe sleep and maternal child health, in order to improve health and infant birth outcomes. Session attendees will learn: 1) how to host a community baby shower 2) the latest SIDS research and how to promote safe sleep practices throughout Kansas communities 3) distribution information about Six Steps to Safety packets and the Kansas Cribs for Kids program 4) and eat cake too! Attendees will receive educational information, training tips and distribution information about *Six Steps to Safety* and the *Kansas Cribs for Kids* program. *Six Steps to Safety* and *Cribs for Kids* information will be distributed to Healthy Start Home Visitors.

**Tell Congress to pass the Stillbirth and SUID Prevention, Education, and Awareness Act (S 1862 / HR 3418)**—The Stillbirth and SUID Prevention, Education Awareness Act was introduced in Congress on November 14, 2011 with bipartisan support. Please take just a moment to educate yourself on this important bill and share your views with your DC Reps. The issues of accurate data collection, standardized autopsies and investigations as well as resources for states to carry these out are all covered in the bill and affect us all- for the benefit of all. This bill can affect some of the underlying problems we face in addressing the tragedies of unexpected infant and childhood deaths and help make clear progress.
