## Tristin's Story

Christmas has always been my favorite time of year. Not only do I love being able to celebrate the birth of our Savior, but I love the lights, decorations, and the snow. So, when Noah and I (Anna) saw that

positive test on Christmas Day of 2010, we felt extremely blessed. Our first daughter, Harley, was so excited to be a big sister. At our first prenatal appointment in January, we learned that God had blessed us, not with just one new addition, but TWO! A girl and a boy. On July 9, 2011, our babies came into this world 8 weeks early. After going into preterm labor, I was rushed into and emergency cesarean section due to our baby boy

being breach. Our daughter, Rustin, was born first. Her cord was wrapped tightly around her neck twice. Two minutes later, our son, Tristin Robert Lee was born. Tristin was determined he was coming out breach. He even turned back around after the doctor had flipped him. Tristin's cord was wrapped around his neck once. We were later told that if I would not have gone into preterm labor and if I had not have had a c-section, we would have lost both of our children. Tristin spent three weeks in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) and Rustin was kept for five weeks. While in the NICU, Tristin was diagnosed with galactosemia (a metabolic disorder involving the galactose in milk). He was put on a soy formula diet, and he began gaining strength daily. This ended our adventures in breastfeeding, but it also gave Noah and Tristin time to bond through bottle feedings. We had finally had our family all together, and we were starting to get into our routines.

On November 13, 2011, on Harley's second birthday, we dedicated our babies to the Lord at our church. We were surrounded by family and friends as we gave our children up to the Lord to do His will in them. We spent Thanksgiving going from one family member's home to another, and all of our families were able to spend time with our precious children.

On the morning of December 21, 2011, Noah was not feeling well, so he decided to stay home and rest and to be with his family. It was a very normal day. We fed, changed diapers, Harley played peek-a-boo with Tristin (he was just starting to laugh), and then I laid my babies in their cribs for their naps. Tristin would sleep through anything. So, when I glanced into his crib the few times I was in and out of the nursery, nothing struck me as odd. Four hours after I laid Tristin down

for his nap, when I went to wake him for his next feeding, he was gone. Noah performed CPR and the paramedics also tried, but it was too late. I do not know how, but by the time the detective and police chaplain told us our sweet baby boy had passed away, our entire family was in our front yard. Noah and I both already knew that he was gone; we just did not want to believe it. We were praying for a miracle. We just didn't realize at the time how many miracles we had already received with Tristin. This was just four days before Christmas. I was supposed to be shopping for our twins' first Christmas, not picking out a casket and planning a funeral. Tristin Robert Lee McLaughlin passed away from Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) at just 5 months and 12 days of age. The day after he died, it snowed. We laid our son to rest the day after Christmas on December 26, 2011.

The KIDS Network (then the SIDS Network) was there for us every step of the way. The KIDS Network had called us after receiving a phone call from our friends. The KIDS Network talked us through the next steps in our journey, explaining to us how the investigation process in a SIDS case works, what to expect with the coroner's report and death certificate, and sending us a package including information on grieving the loss of a twin. We were also connected with other families who had experienced the same type of loss and were able to get advice from other parents. This especially was helpful when I had unexpectedly become pregnant with our rainbow baby shortly after Tristin's death. We have always felt respected as parents who have lost a child and we were always able to get answers to our questions (those that could be answered when it comes to a SIDS death), and reassurance for our insecurities.

We feel very honored to be chosen as the 2015 Step Up for KIDS Ambassador Family. We believe that God has guided our journey this far and that He will continue to guide us to the end. We pray that one day, SIDS will be preventable, that all babies will be born healthy and vibrant and that the innocence of children will never be lost.

Thank you for this opportunity. I pray you all will find peace and comfort wherever you are in your journey. God bless.

## Susan E. Bredehoff Candle Lighting Memorial

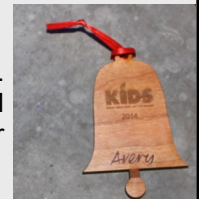

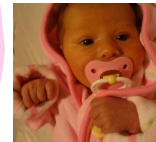

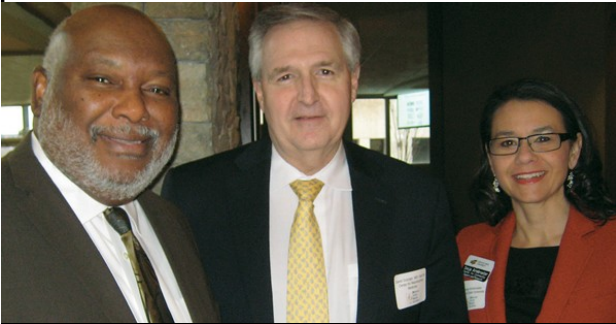
# Maternal Infant Health Summit

The Maternal Infant Health Coalition is dedicated to making Sedgwick County the best place for children to be born and grow. To achieve that goal the MIHC gathered on Friday, February 13, 2015 at the Kansas Leadership Center to draw together the critical voices to formulate a comprehensive, collaborative plan of action.
