Beckett's Story

We had been anxiously waiting for this day since we found out that we were pregnant. I was 19 weeks and we were thrilled to be going for our anatomy sono. We were quite certain that we were having a girl and already had the name picked out. When the sono tech told us we were having a boy, we were completely shocked. My husband was convinced he could only make girls. However shocked we were, we were equally as excited. As the sono progressed, my husband and I, started noticing that the limb measurements were 6 weeks behind the rest of his body. Our emotions quickly turned into worry and concern. We verbalized to the tech that we noticed his measurements and asked if this was normal. Being that we were medical professionals, we knew that it wasn't, but wanted her to assure us that it was okay. She told us that it wasn't and then proceeded to tell us that we would see a specialist...and oh yeah, don't google anything. How do you go from total joy to complete devastation in a matter of minutes? I didn't make it as far as the waiting room before I broke down. We had planned on going shopping immediately after the sono to buy our baby an outfit, instead we went straight home. We knew that his type of abnormalities meant that he could possibly have Down's Syndrome or maybe he would even be a little person. We didn't care, we would love him no matter what.

As the shock of not having a "healthy" pregnancy weighed heavily on us, we knew we didn't want the kids to know just yet. We had a gender reveal for the kids that night and they were thrilled to be getting a baby brother. A week went by with no news. It was excruciating. At my OB appointment I was still expecting her to tell us it would be fine, that he would catch up. This cannot be happening to us. We did everything right in preparing for this pregnancy. We did not receive the good news that we were hoping to hear. She informed us that he had a form of skeletal dysplasia and that the radiologist felt comfortable in saying it would be fatal. Fatal. This is something you just can't even begin to comprehend. In a world full of advanced medicine and there was nothing we could do to fix him.

We had an appointment to see the specialist that next week. He confirmed that our son did have a form of skeletal dysplasia. We were given many options during this appointment. The one that stuck out to me the most was when he told us that we could terminate the pregnancy.



This made me more upset than receiving his actual diagnosis. Although we were very scared, we were not going to let this define him or how we felt about him. From this moment on, we knew we would do whatever it took to protect him. God had chosen us to be his parents and we were going to give him every fighting chance that we could. We loved him with every ounce of our being. Being without him was NEVER an option for us. He was going to stay safe in my tummy up until the end. Not soon after that we met with the genetics counselor and she told us right away that he had a grim prognosis. She told us that we would have to make decisions for him that no parent should have to make after he was born. We were going to be planning a funeral instead of a joyous homecoming. This was not how this was supposed to be. We had already planned a future with our baby. Even though his prognosis was grim, we always had a glimmer of hope. He was a fighter, he was strong...he was our son! We knew that however much time we had with him, he would be surrounded by love. His name was going to be Beckett Lee. He would have his daddy's middle name.

As a family, we decided that he was going to be a part of everything we did and go everywhere we went. We got a large, wooden letter B that we painted blue to represent Beckett. His "B" has become a staple in our family. He was able to be a part of so many things, and go to so many places. Beckett's "B" will continue to be a part of every journey we take. His nickname became Super B. We even had a superhero cape and mask made for him.



Beckett's thoracic cavity never grew past 24 weeks which caused my amniotic fluid levels to become severely elevated. At 32 weeks, the specialist drained 4 liters of amniotic fluid from my belly. Immediately I started having contractions and was sent to the hospital for observation. The contractions never stopped and it caused him distress. This was it, it was time to say goodbye. He was born by c-section at 2:30 that morning. He was intubated but it did not help him. Dan and I made the most painful decision we have ever had to make and they removed the tube. We just wanted to hold him in our arms and surround him with love. For the next two hours we did just that. He passed peacefully in my arms two hours later with his entire family around him.

Although our journey has been truly heartbreaking, we would do it all over again to spend two more hours with him. There is not a second that goes by that I don't think of my Beckett, but it is comforting to know he only knew pure love in his lifetime.

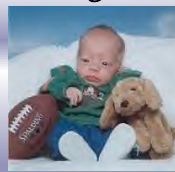

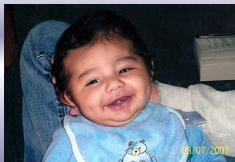
