## Kansas Infant Death and SIDS

Our story, probably like many of yours, began in August of 2010 when my husband, Kevin, and I found out we were pregnant with our first child. Of all the things I had ever wanted to be, being a mother was at the top of my list. We did birthing classes, I took prenatal vitamins like it was my job, I bought



books on parenting and birthing techniques and we prepared ourselves for what we thought would be the best year of our lives. My pregnancy was fairly uneventful, and our healthy baby boy was born on March 31st, 2011 - weighing in at 7 lbs even and 20 inches long. Maxton was an absolutely adorable baby. He had the perfect skin, tiny white hairs where his eyebrows were supposed to be and the cutest cleft chin.



I took Maxton everywhere with me—we went on daily outings, on walks, traveled to see family out of town, went to sporting events. He was a bit spoiled and cried when he was put down so most of my days were spent holding the handsome little man. I slept holding him, ate holding him and waited to shower until Kevin came home so that he could hold him. I wasn't sure how the transition back to work was going to go. I was working at a Credit Union, the same credit union where Kevin and I met, when Max was born. Kevin and I decided that I would take six full weeks of maternity leave and then

would work 1/2 days for the seventh week to ease back into the swing of things. We had an amazing daycare provider with excellent references lined up. I was as ready as I was going to be.

My first day back was May 16th. I got Max ready and we headed to daycare. I visited a bit with the daycare provider about how he liked his bottles, that he usually slept on his stomach and that I was sorry if he wanted to be held all day. She told me that she would take great care of him, would put him to bed on his back in a pack and play and that usually it just took a week or two for babies to get in a routine at her house. I picked Max up that evening and the provider mentioned that she was surprised I hadn't called every hour to check on him like most new moms. We discussed how great the day went and then Max and I headed home. I don't remember much about that evening. I do know that I wasn't feeling well so Max slept in his crib for the first time ever during his nap. We watched TV and snuggled.

The next day I was scheduled to work during the afternoon, so Max and I took it slow that morning. We did all the things he loved—took a bath, rocked in the rocker while he ate, and then I combed his hair while we sang songs. Before dropping him off we ran to Walgreens so that I could get his newborn pictures printed. I remember that for the first time he was pretty fussy during our trip, so I sat in the back of my car and breastfed him. He didn't seem satisfied, so I also gave him a bottle. His daycare was only 2 minutes away, so we loaded up and headed to daycare. When we got there, I sat on the couch and finished giving him his bottle. He was quiet and relaxed. I kissed him, told him I loved him and

handed him to the provider. They followed me to the door and I waved to my beautiful boy as I walked to my car.

I got to work and talked with my supervisor for a while. I hadn't been there for more than 2 hours when a police officer walked into the building - he asked to talk to my supervisor. They talked for just a minute and then approached my desk. They told me that I needed to go with the officer as my son was sick. The only thing they could tell me was that he had stopped breathing at daycare but was in route to the ER and that he was still alive.



The next few hours were a whirlwind. Kevin and I were asked to sit in a room and wait for what seemed like forever. My mom showed up even though I told her not to come because I was sure Max would be fine. We were finally allowed to see our baby. There were so many people in his ER room all working to save him. We were met by police officers who asked us all sorts of questions while we were watching our son lay completely still with so many tubes coming from his tiny little body. It was after that we were told that Maxton's daycare provider had found him turning blue in his portable crib and that she called 911. The firefighters and paramedics were able to get his heart started, but he never started breathing on his own again. He was on a breathing machine at that point and they moved him to the pediatric intensive care unit.

He was there for nine days. Nine days we stayed with him constantly, hoping and praying that there would be a miracle. He had extensive testing done and was seen by many excellent health care teams. The testing showed that Max would never breathe on his own because he had no brain function. Our families gathered, and our son was taken off of life support. He died as Kevin and I held him in our arms.

As I sit here and contemplate writing "an end" to our story I am uncertain as to what to include. Do I tell you that our families struggled to find a new

at the KIDS Network and our friends, that were our saving grace and helped us see hope? Or do I tell you that we are now stronger, as individuals and as a family because of the lessons we learned from Maxton's short life? I'm not sure that I really need to write anything. I know that as supporters of the KIDS Network you "get it". You get what it feels like to lose a child. You get that there will be good days and bad days for the rest of your life. And you also get that by working with the KIDS Network we are helping to limit the tragedy of infant death so that others don't ever have to go through the unthinkable.

## KIDS Network Celebrating 20th Anniversary in 2018

Two decades? Sometimes it seems like yesterday that the KIDS Network was founded; sometimes it seems like a century ago. We'll be marking this milestone and the programs and people involved as 2018 rolls along. Below is a list of many key events and developments. What it doesn't include, though, are the names of the board members and others who helped carry out the KIDS Network's mission of serving individuals affected by infant death and SIDS, and in instituting programs and research that will bring an end to these tragedies. We plan on recognizing their generous service, too, during 2018.



- 1998:** Ted and Susan Bredehoft of Wichita begin the Network after the death of their granddaughter, Haley Elizabeth Slaymaker, in 1997.
- 2000:** The first Haley's Scramble for SIDS Golf Tournament is held, named after Haley Elizabeth Slaymaker. First candlelight vigil held, later named Susan E. Bredehoft Candle Light Memorial in memory of Network founder.  
Hired Christy Schunn, LCSW as part-time director.
- 2002:** Statewide Six Steps for Safety safe-sleep program was launched at Governor's Conference on Public Health.
- 2002 -2012:** Worked collaboratively on legislation and regulation to include safe sleep training for childcare providers
- 2004:** Ellen Patterson, LCSW was hired as director.  
Christy Schunn coordinated 1<sup>st</sup> annual Step Up for Kids 5K fund-raiser, with memorial and other events added in future years.
- 2005:** Christy Schunn returned as director.
- 2007:** Organization rebranded as SIDS Network of Kansas.  
Implemented Sudden Unexpected Infant Death Investigation (SUIDI) guidelines for first responders statewide.
- 2007-2015:** Served on the National Association of SIDS and Infant Mortality Programs (ASIP).
- 2008:** Completed Kansas Public Health Leadership Institute Capstone project, Implementation of Safe Sleep in Birthing Hospitals.
- 2009:** Collaborated with the Governor's Blue Ribbon panel on infant mortality to implement Fetal Infant Mortality Review statewide.
- 2010:** Statewide Cribs for Kids program launched at Governor's Conference on Public Health.
- 2011:** Developed & implemented Safe Sleep Community Baby Shower in collaboration with Wichita Black Nurses Association.
- 2012:** Medical Society of Sedgwick County Physician Safe Sleep Task Force was created.
- 2012-2017:** Co-facilitated Maternal Infant Health Coalition in Sedgwick County.
- 2013:** Rebranded as KIDS Infant Death & SIDS Network to reflect changing and expanded mission.
- 2014:** Collaborated with KU School of Medicine Community Work Group to provide statewide assistance with fetal infant mortality reviews.
- 2015:** Piloted Safe Sleep Instructor Project funded by March of Dimes.  
Co-hosted Infant Mortality Summit.
- 2016-2018:** Implemented Statewide Safe Sleep Infrastructure funded in part by Kansas Department of Health and Environment's Maternal Child Health Bureau. Includes Safe Sleep Instructor certification, Physician Safe Sleep Toolkit, Safe Sleep Community Baby Shower, and Safe Sleep Hospital Certification Program.

## Infant Mortality: 'It's Too High Every Year'

The work of the KIDS Network is driven by the belief that every year, if an infant died a preventable death, is a bad – and sad – year.

Recent statistics for the state and Wichita demonstrate the continued need for many and multipronged approaches to preventing infant deaths from SIDS and sleep-related factors.

Last year, Wichita had six infant deaths linked to sleep issues, compared to 2016 when they had jumped to 12. Many of those deaths were attributable to co-bedding of baby and mother or other adult, including ones where the home had a crib, but it wasn't used. Additional causes of death reflect other unsafe practices – sleeping in an adult bed, a swing or a car seat – that safe sleep advocates have tried to combat for years.

"This is the reminder of why, for 20 years, we do what we do," Christy Schunn, KIDS Network executive director, said of the statistics and the Network's work across two decades.

Statewide numbers for recent years show some progress in reducing infant deaths, but also point to tremendous challenges and disparities. Thankfully, over the past two decades, sudden unexpected infant deaths have dropped in numbers. Infant mortality rates remain higher in Sedgwick County than the rest of the state, particularly among African-Americans.

Together, the statistics point to the enduring need for vigilance and efforts to educate about unsafe sleeping practices and behaviors. "Infant mortality is trending downward, but not rapidly enough," Schunn said.

## Fund-Raising Task Force Studies Sustainability & Options

The KIDS Network does its work through fundraisers, generous donors and grants from the state, private foundations and others.

As past years have shown public funding often shifts. KIDS is in the process of applying for numerous private grants, with the results to be seen.

To remove some uncertainty from the funding situation, the KIDS Board of Directors is creating a fund-raising task force to examine ways to ensure the sustainability of our organization.

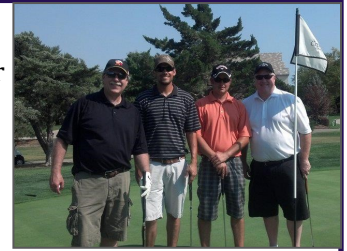

## Research Spreads the Word About the KIDS Network

A recent study on perceptions about baby boxes by KIDS-affiliated researchers, along with mentions in other national publications, illustrate the soundness of two decades of evidence-based efforts here in Kansas.

The study, "Qualitative Assessment of Pregnant Women's Perceptions of Infant Sleep Boxes," was published in November 2017 in *Global Pediatric Health*. It was written by Cari Ahlers-Schmidt, Christy Schunn, Michelle Redmond, Sharla Smith, Molly Brown, Dr. Stephanie Kuhlmann, Matthew Engel, and Mary Benton.

The work is intended to add some perspective on the issue of infant sleep boxes, which have been popular but are largely unregulated. KIDS' position is that, lacking extensive study, it's still best to use a safety-approved crib, which is in line with other experts' advice.

In January, the Centers for Disease Control noted the importance of developing effective messages and educational tools for caregivers, addressing disparities and barriers to safe sleep, as well as providing cribs to at-risk families. The CDC publication drew on work by Dr. Rachel Moon, who has noted the use of community baby showers such as the one put on in Wichita by KIDS and the Black Nurses Association.



"This is why we collect data before and after each baby shower," Christy Schunn said of the showers. "The data is evidence that the safe sleep community baby shower approach improves knowledge and intention to sleep infants in a safe environment."
